THE PROGRAM

South Plains College Workforce Development class in Blueprint Reading will equip students with knowledge in blueprint reading for residential and light commercial construction. Individuals in the course will be able to distinguish correct scale prints for architecture and engineering renderings; distinguish appropriate scale tools needed; identify construction blueprint symbols and abbreviations; interpret a set of construction contract documents; correlate elevations, sections, details, plan views, schedules, and general notes. The class is a 10-week course of 50 hours. Student will receive 5.0 CEU's. The program is limited to fifteen (15) students.
